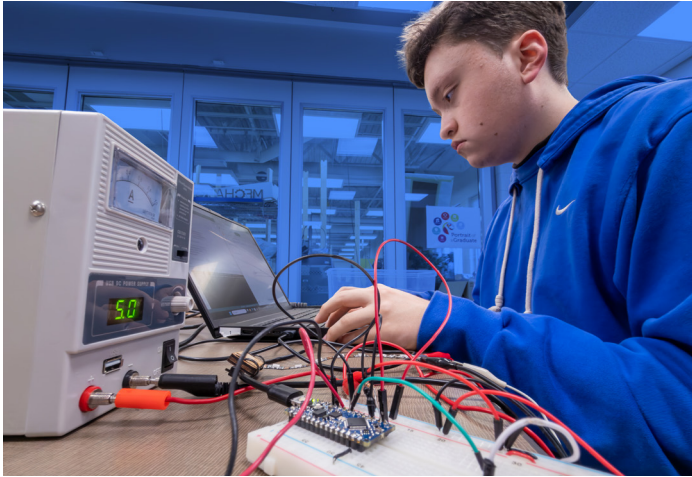

WHAT IS TSA?

The Technology Student Association (TSA) is a national organization of students in STEM. We learn, design, & build projects (see below) to compete with other schools for awards! We also have volunteering & leadership opportunities!



COMMITMENT?

TSA can be flexible with your schedule. Choose as many projects as you want, attend as many conferences as you can, & have as much fun as you want! It's possible to be in sports, music, & other activities, while also excelling in school and TSA.



ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN

Plan, design, and build a prototype! You'll also learn new skills like CAD or using power tools. You'll bring your building to compete at conferences for awards.



BOARD GAME DESIGN

Write, design, & make a physical game you can play! You'll learn skills such as new design software or using power tools, and you'll bring your game to SLC to compete for awards.



DIGITAL VIDEO PRODUCTION

Use digital audio and video technology to record, and edit a short film with a prompt! Semifinalists complete a challenge at SLC to make a short film.



FASHION DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

Design and make an outfit that integrates technology! You'll learn new skills like sewing and drawing. At SLC, you'll bring your outfit to compete for awards.



MANUFACTURING PROTOTYPE

You get to design, create, and use high-tech equipment to develop and pitch a product along a yearly prompt to compete for awards at SLC.



VIDEO GAME DESIGN

Use coding software, sound design, and animations to create your own playable video game! Semifinalists at SLC give a playthrough and presentation for judges to compete for awards.

GENERAL MEETINGS

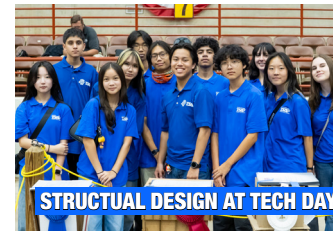
